Snow Removal

To assist the Public Works staff with snow removal, we ask that you do not leave vehicles on the streets for extended periods of time. Not only does this make for a difficult job removing snow, it can also pose a dangerous situation. During the winter, the streets can be quite icy, making a vehicle on the street a perfect target for an accident that could have easily been avoided. **Vehicles are not supposed to be left parked on the street any longer than 48 hours, according to the Town's Traffic bylaw.**
