

Bylaw No. 701

A Bylaw of the Town of Davidson to Amend Bylaw 696-A, being a Bylaw to Regulate and Establish Rates for the Disposal of Wastes in the Town Waste Disposal Grounds

The Council of the Town of Davidson, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts to amend Bylaw 696-A as follows:

1. Schedule "A" to Bylaw 696-A is deleted and replaced with the following:

Schedule "A"

ENTRY FEE SCHEDULE

<u>FEE PER LOAD</u>	<u>LOAD SIZE</u>
\$ 5	½ ton truck or utility trailer or anything smaller
\$ 15	¾ or 1 ton truck
\$ 25	2 or 3 ton truck
\$ 50	4 ton or tandem truck
\$ 75	Semi

Load size shall be determined by the Town of Davidson or its agent, whose decision will be final.

If the load is mixed types of waste, it must be sorted by the person wishing to dispose of the waste into the appropriate designated areas.

If the load is mixed types of waste and the person wishing to dispose of the waste does NOT sort the waste into the appropriate designated areas, an additional fee will be charged according to the following:

<u>ADDITIONAL FEE PER LOAD</u>	<u>LOAD SIZE (UNSORTED)</u>
\$ 20	½ ton truck or utility trailer or anything smaller
\$ 30	¾ or 1 ton truck
\$ 50	2 or 3 ton truck
\$ 90	4 ton or tandem truck or semi

2. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect when adopted by Council.
