

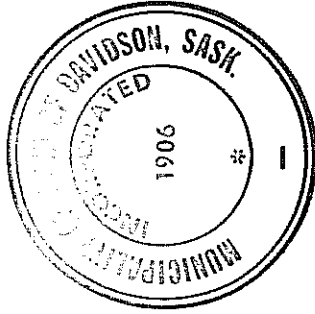
A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF DAVIDSON TO REGULATE THE OPERATION OF ALL
TERRAIN VEHICLES

1. In this bylaw:
 - (a) "All Terrain Vehicle" means all terrain vehicles as defined in The ALL Terrain Vehicles Act.
 - (b) "Private Land" means land other than public land
 - (c) "Public Land" means public land as defined in The All Terrain Vehicles Act.
2. No person shall operate an all terrain vehicle on any private land within the corporate limits of the Town of Davidson without the permission of the owner or occupant of the land.
3. No person shall operate an all terrain vehicle on any public land within the corporate limits of the Town of Davidson.
4. No person shall operate an all terrain vehicle on any street or lane within the corporate limits of the Town of Davidson.
5. Any person convicted of an offense under any section of this bylaw shall be liable to a fine of \$100.00 plus legal costs incurred by the Town of Davidson in enforcing this bylaw.

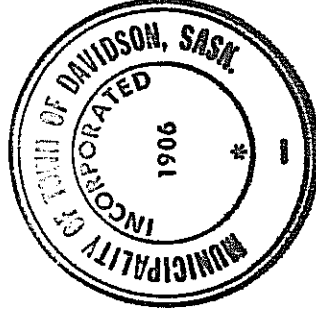
