Permitted Waste	Unpermitted Waste
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Household waste • Waste resulting from the handling, preparation, cooking and consumption of food • Compostable materials: grass clippings, vegetable scraps • Wood, trees, shrubs, stumps, branches, unpainted wood/pallets • Clean soil/fill will be accepted free of charge, provided it contains <u>NO</u>: wood, stumps, branches, concrete, asphalt, metal or metal parts/pieces, plastic, ceramics/masonry material, refuse/garbage, rocks over 4” in diameter, chemicals that are regulated by the Ministry of Environment: hydrocarbons, halogenated hydrocarbons, petroleum hydrocarbons • Whites: large metal objects such as major appliances, water heaters, stoves, furnaces, washers, dryers, refrigerators, deep freezes, dishwashers, bed springs, etc. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tires • Batteries • Chemical containers • Paint cans (can be taken to Sarcan) • Used oil, used oil filters, fuel • Hot ashes • Propane tanks • Asbestos • Dead animals • Manure • Grain • Slaughter house wastes • Recyclables • Chemicals that are regulated by the Ministry of Environment: hydrocarbons, halogenated hydrocarbons, petroleum hydrocarbons • Liquid domestic waste
